## **Activities of CICTAB: Training Programmes**

 International Programme on "Agriculture & Rural Development through Cooperative Business Model" (CICTAB-VAMNICOM-IFFCO-FMDI)

3rd - 6th Oct, 2023 at IFFCO FMDI, Gurgaon, Haryana, India

International programme on "Agriculture and Rural Development through Cooperative Business Model" was conducted from 3rd – 6th October, 2023 at FMDI, Gurgaon, New Delhi.

The program was inaugurated by Santosh Kumar Shukla, Joint GM (CD) in the presence of DP Singal, Dy. GM (Training), FMDI, Smt. Anita Chaudhary, Rajneesh Pandel, Dr D Ravi, Consultant, CICTAB.

The theme of the programme was showcasing rural development through cooperative business model. In context of the theme, the topics covered in the programme were Business Development Plan for a cooperative organization; IFFCO Nano Urea & Nano DAP revolutionary products: Application, profitability & its role in increasing the farmer's income; Importance of IFFCO Bio-Fertilizers & Bio-decomposer in sustainable agriculture; Credit & Banking in Rural Area; Role of Bio-Stimulants (Sagarika & Humiffco) and Bio-Pesticides in Productivity; Importance of Integrated Nutrient Management System in sustainable agriculture; Importance of IFFCO's WSF & Specialty Fertilizers in Modern Agriculture.

The field visit participants were arranged at NAFED and IFFCO headquarters located at Saket to learn about cooperative governance and the successful cooperative model in India. The participants made country paper presentations.

The International Programme on "Innovation and Application of Financial Technology in Rural Financial Institutions" was organized during 6th – 9th November, 2023 at VAMNICOM, Pune.

A total number of 13 participants attended the on-line programme from two countries viz., Nepal (05) and India (08).
